

Mezzo-soprano **Kathleen Reveille** is a native of New York's beautiful Hudson Valley. Reveille received a Master of Music from Yale University and a Bachelor of Music from Mercyhurst University. Previous engagements include Maddalena *Rigoletto* and Flora *La traviata* at The Hudson Opera Theatre, Mezzo Soloist Mozart *Requiem* at Carnegie Hall with Cecilia Chorus of New York, and Zia Principessa *Suor Angelica* for the New Haven Symphony.
